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HOW THE HOLY SPIRIT WORKS IN OUR LIVES

- Powerfully convicts our hearts with the gospel
 - We can insult the Holy Spirit
 - We can resist the Holy Spirit
- God sends him into our hearts
 - Given the Holy Spirit
 - Receive the Holy Spirit
- Washed, sanctified and justified by the Holy Spirit
- The Holy Spirit dwells in us, lives in us
- The Holy Spirit gives us spiritual gifts
- We can choose to live by, walk by the Holy Spirit
- Our flesh is in conflict with the Holy Spirit
 - We can try to lie to or test the Holy Spirit
 - We can grieve the Holy Spirit
 - We can quench the Holy Spirit
- We can choose to be led by the Holy Spirit
- We can be filled with the Holy Spirit
- We can be prompted by the Holy Spirit
- In time the fruit of the Holy Spirit develops in us

HOW THE HOLY SPIRIT WORKS IN OUR LIVES

- Powerfully convicts our hearts with the gospel (I Thessalonians 1:4-5)
 - We can insult the Spirit (Heb. 10:26-29)
 - We can resist the Holy Spirit (Acts 7:51)
- God sends him into our hearts (Galatians 4:6)
 - Given the Holy Spirit (Acts 5:32, 15:8)
 - Receive the Spirit (Acts 8:15, 19, 10:47)
- Washed, sanctified and justified by the Holy Spirit (I Corinthians 6:9-11)
- The Holy Spirit dwells in us, lives in us (Rom 8:11, I Corinthians 3:16, 6:19)
- The Holy Spirit gives us spiritual gifts (I Cor. 12)
- We can choose to live by, walk by the Holy Spirit (Romans 8:5, I Corinthians 3:1, Galatians 5:16)
- Our flesh is in conflict with the Holy Spirit (Galatians 5:16-18)
 - We can try to lie to or test the Holy Spirit (Acts 5:3, 9)
 - We can grieve the Holy Spirit (Eph. 4:30)
 - We can quench the Spirit (I Thes. 5:19)
- We can choose to be led by the Holy Spirit (Romans 8:14, Galatians 5:18)
- We can be filled with the Holy Spirit (Acts 9:17)
 - Acts 2:4, 10:44-46, 19:6 (other languages)
 - Acts 4:8, 31, 6:10, 13:9 (speak w/ boldness)
 - Acts 6:5, 11:24 (description of people)
- Receive encouragement, joy and hope from the Holy Spirit (Acts 9:31, 13:52, Romans 15:13)
- We can be prompted by the Holy Spirit (Acts 8:29, 11:12, 13:2-4, 20:22-23, 21:4)
- In time the fruit of the Holy Spirit develops in us (Galatians 5:22-23)
