

Job	Book of Job	Bankrupt, death of children, loss of health, marital strife	Prayerfully, tearfully and humbly wait on God
Joseph	Genesis 37-50, especially 42:21, 40:14-15	Sibling rivalry and hatred, rejection, slavery, imprisoned, falsely accused	Humbly faithful to God, waited on God, served others
Moses	Numbers 11:10-18	Great success that led to being overworked, huge sense of responsibility	Prayer, prompted by God to share the load with godly men
Naomi Ruth	Ruth 1:1-5, 11:13, 20-22	Loss of husband and sons, loss, poverty	Live a humble, obedient life of service
Hannah (Sarah, Rachel, Elizabeth)	I Sam 1, Gen 16:1-2, 30:1-2, Luke 1:25	Infertility	Wait on God, trust in him even if never have a child
David	Psalm 42, 43, 51, 55, I Sam 30:6	Saul jealous, life threatened, adultery, lies, murdered, his own men and son threatened his life	Cried out to and waited on God, found strength in God, confessed sin

Person	Scripture	Circumstance	Resolution
Elijah	I Kings 19	Spiritual victory led to life being threatened	God-given rest, food, time off, quietness, prayer, and God-given correct perspective
Jeremiah	Lamentations 1:20, 2:11 3:19-33	Prophet of God that no one would listen to, hated, judged, imprisoned, life threatened	Persevered through great trial, trusting God would reward
Jonah	Jonah 4:6-11	Mad at God for being gracious to Jonah and Israel's enemies	Rebuke by God, given God's perspective
Peter	Matthew 26:74-75	Cowardly act, denied Christ	Jesus found him, forgave him
Paul	II Cor. 1:8-11	Great suffering, troubles, pressure, despair lives threatened	Relied on God, set hope on God, prayers of others
Jesus	Matt 26:36-50 Hebrews 4:7-9	Overwhelming sorrow, deeply distressed, in anguish	Prayed to Father, accepted God's will
