CROSSROADS LEADERSHIP COUNCIL NOMINATIONS

1. The Crossroads Leadership Council (CLC) is to be made up of 5 to 9 members (not including the Senior Pastor).
2. A potential CLC member must have been a church attender at Crossroads for at least 2 years. He/She must have experience serving in ministry areas during their time attending Crossroads and also agree to a legal background check.
3. Each CLC Member is asked to serve at least a two year term, and can serve a maximum of 3 two year terms for a total of 6 years before stepping off of the Council. Following one year off of the Leadership Council an individual can be nominated and re-appointed to the CLC.
4. At present there are 7 CLC Members (Rob Callahan, Kelly Bottoms, John Snyder, Brad Swim, David Autrey, Glenna Johnson and Jennifer Freitas).
5. By our bylaws a Nominating Committee must be put in place to accept nominations from the congregation. (A member of the Nominating Committee can be nominated.)
6. The responsibilities of the Nominating Committee are to contact those qualifying individuals to ask if they are willing to have their names submitted to the CLC for consideration and then follow up with those who agree with the process.
7. Once the list of names is compiled, the CLC will set up interviews with each individual. (The goal is to do the interviews during the month of February, 2020)
8. Once the individuals have all been interviewed the CLC will seek to prayerfully make a decision.

BYLAWS

III. CROSSROADS LEADERSHIP COUNCIL

Section 1. Numbers and Qualifications. The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed and governed by the Crossroads Leadership Council (CLC) composed of not less than five (5) nor more than nine (9) directors and the Senior Pastor. Only Members in good standing, who have been Members for at least two (2) years, can constitute the CLC.

Section 4. Nominating Committee. The Nominating Committee shall consist of not less than five (5), nor more than nine (9) Members of CCC, as designated by the CLC, one of whom will be designated the Chairman by the CLC. The Nominating Committee shall make as many nominations for appointment by the CLC as it shall in its discretion determine, but not less than the number of vacancies that are to be filled. Such nominations shall be made from among the Members of the congregation, provided the nominee has been previously consulted and has consented to submission of his/her name and has been a Member in good standing for at least two (2) years.

Section 5. Appointment. Appointment to the CLC shall be made by the CLC from the nominees submitted by the Nominating Committee.

ARTICLE I

Section 5. Membership Requirements. A Member shall be in good standing where such Member has accepted Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior and signs a statement that they have read and agree with the Statement of Faith, the Purpose Statement and the Values of the ministry of CCC.
