We are so excited to worship together again. We understand you probably have questions about what to expect during weekend services.

HERE'S WHAT TO EXPECT:



You must reserve a seat prior to the weekend service. By registering for this event you are agreeing that you will not attend the event if you are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms. To register go to VisitCrossroads.com. You can register up to 8 people at a time.



Families of the same household are welcome to sit together. For now there will be NO children's ministry, 4FIVE, or Garage student ministry during service times. We will have a children's segment as part of all weekend services AND we are crafting our time together with sensitivity to the shorter attention span of children.



All seating is first come first serve for each of the worship areas. However, outside doors will not be open until 30 minutes before the service time. Only a certain number of people will be allowed in each of the available rooms.



You must wear a mask. It will be hard to not see your smiling faces but safety first. Those under 2-year-old or those in which a mask would compromise their health are not required to wear a mask.



We know everyone will want to give each other hugs but please social distance. Air hugs or air high fives will be accepted.



We will not be handing anything out during service. This includes coffee, donuts, communion, activity pages for children and passing the offering.



Restrooms will have the same social distancing requirements, which means a limited amount of people can use the restrooms at one time.



We will be sanitizing everything between services. If possible, please bring your own hand sanitizing supply.
